Rules and regulations

### Tournament Rules

(All participants (Teams) are to observe the rules set by the Tournament Organisers at all times.

1. Good conduct and maturity must be practised at all times.

1.1 All players must produce the following documents before playing.

- Original Identity documents ( NO COPIES)
- Green Book
- Smart Card
- Valid Driver's Licence
- Passport

1.2 **NO DOCUMENTS NO PLAY**

2. The Tournament will be played by Masters Division (1989) with only two players born in (1990) to remain in the field of the play at all times.

3. Teams must be ready to play 10 minutes before the scheduled time.

- A team that is 15 minutes late prior to kick off will automatically be 1 nil down ( 1 goal will be awarded to the respective opponents) and the remaining minutes of that game will be played.
- A TEAM THAT IS 30 MINUTES LATE SHALL RESULT IN THAT TEAM LOSING THE MATCH BY WALK OVER AND THAT TEAM WHICH WAS SCHEDULED TO PLAY THEM WILL ADVANCE TO THE NEXT STAGE.

4. The games will play for 35 minutes per half ( 70 minutes full game).

- Interval will be 10 minutes
- In case of both teams playing to a stalemate, penalties will decide the winner of that match. NO EXTRA TIME.
- 5. (Top 16 Top 8) >>>> Red card will result in that player send off and he will not play in the next game should his team advance to the next stage of the Tournament

- (Semi-finals)>>>> A red card in the semi-finals will result in that player send off for that particular match **BUT SHOULD THAT TEAM WISH FOR THAT PLAYER TO PLAY IN THE FINAL, THE TEAM WILL HAVE TO PAY R500 COMPENSATION fee FOR THAT PLAYER to play the final.**

( Rough and Dirty game is not encouraged)

6. No official/s will be allowed in the field of play at any given time.

- The referee or his assistants will give indication for ½ officials to enter the field in case of an injury.

**7. A TEAM OR OFFICAL/s WHO ASSAULT THE REFEREE OR HIS ASSISTANTS WILL BE DISQUALIFIED FROM THE TOURNAMENT, THE COMMITTEE AND THE VICTIM WILL OPEN A CASE OF ASSULT AGAINST THE PERPETRATOR/S AT THE POLICE STATION.**

8. Referee fee of R150 per match, per team will be paid for the duration of the tournament ( R150x4)

9. Each team must bring 1 soccer ball to the tournament.

10. A team fixture first on the fixtures will be considered a Home Team and they have the privilege of using their preferred jersey colour.

- A team fixture second on the fixtures will be considered an Away team and they must have a different colour jerseys to avoid clashes.

11. A team is allowed to make 6 (5+1) substitution during the game.

**12. REFEREES DECISION IS FINAL.**

**13. NO REUND**

- The tournament will start on the 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> of April (Top16) and 01 May (Top 8) then end on the 4<sup>th</sup> May ( Semi-Finals) 2024
